



INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

Manuscripts must be submitted only through the submission form, observing the IMPORTANT DATES mentioned on the website (www.spaceweeknordeste.com) for submission deadlines.

There is no maximum limit on the number of co-authors per paper, nor a limit on the number of papers per author. All co-authors must be included in the submission form so that the proceedings and program can be prepared without errors.

Only files in PDF format will be accepted. Submissions must be extended abstracts of up to five (5) pages, including figures, tables, formulas, and references. DO NOT NUMBER THE PAGES.

The formatting of the manuscript must strictly follow the guidelines provided in the template available on the SWN-2026 website. Papers that do not comply with the guidelines will be rejected. Special care is recommended in the preparation of the abstract and in the overall formatting of the manuscript. A template for the abstract is available at (www.spaceweeknordeste.com).

Submitted papers will be reviewed by an independent Technical-Scientific Committee, composed of professionals from all relevant areas. The main criteria for paper acceptance are:

- Authors are responsible for the originality and revision of the abstract;
- Relevance of the topic to the Symposium's Scientific Topics;
- Scientific rigor and data quality;
- Abstract quality and clarity of the text;
- Quality of the presentation;
- Formation in accordance with the established guidelines.

Observation: There will be no poster session; only oral presentations will be held.

The slides of papers submitted and accepted for oral presentation during SWN 2026 must use the template that will be available at www.spaceweeknordeste.com starting on October 26, 2026.
